1. **basked**: rested in pleasant warmth
2. **buffeted**: struck against powerfully; blow about
3. **horizon**: the line where the sky seems to meet the sea
4. **quay**: a dock where ships are loaded and unloaded
5. **surf**: to ride on waves, often on a surfboard
6. **swell**: a long, large wave that moves along without breaking
7. **swooped**: moved with a sudden, sweeping motion
